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OVERALL RECOMMENDATIONS

The Program Continuous Improvement Plan for this assessment cycle should focus on improving student achievement of PLO 4. Based on the learning outcomes data, the Assessment Analyst of the program recommends the following action(s):

Across program learning outcomes (PLOs), BA Project Management students met or exceeded the acceptable targets for all 2014-15 assignment-based direct measures. However, while BUS 402 (used as a measure of PLO 3, 4, and 6) met or exceeded both acceptable and ideal targets, students underperformed in comparison to other measures. BUS 402 Strategic Management and Business Policy is owned by Ron Beach who says changes to this course are “highly possible” in 2017.

Student scores met or exceeded both the acceptable and ideal targets for each section of the CPC Exam tested for their respective PLOs. In addition, BA Project Management students’ met the acceptable target, but not the ideal target, of the overall CPC exam score.
