OVERALL RECOMMENDATIONS

Across program learning outcomes, BA Social and Criminal Justice students exceeded the acceptable targets for all 2012-13 assessment measures. Students also exceeded or are approaching the ideal targets for all 2012-13 assessment measures.

Overall, it is recommended that College of Liberal Arts Faculty review the assessment plans (including measures used and targets set) in preparation for the 2013-14 assessment cycle. In particular, Faculty may want to review targets set for assignments in courses using Waypoint, courses not yet using Waypoint, and all survey measures to ensure that these targets remain appropriate and meaningful.
