

Where can I find out about Student Conduct and Community Standards Processes?

Will the sanctions go on my student records?

A record of any incident stays with the Office of Student Conduct and Community Standards and contains documents related to the student conduct issue(s) a student had while they were an Ashford student.

Are my records confidential?

Yes. Only certain Ashford University staff members have access to student conduct records.

How long are my records on file?

To comply with federal law, we retain student conduct records seven years from a student's last date of attendance.

Will other schools find out about my record?

The only way other schools will know about a student conduct record with Ashford is if a student voluntarily provides the information or authorizes the other school to view the information. However, egregious violations, e.g. expulsions, may be notated on transcripts.

Will potential employers have access to my student conduct record?

Employers must provide a student's written permission to access their disciplinary records with Ashford University.
