

RN to BSN Nurse Leader Grant

Terms & Conditions

1. ELIGIBILITY: The RN to BSN Nurse Leader Grant (the “Grant”) is open only to new students who begin the RN to BSN program between July 1, 2016 and June 30, 2017. This Grant will reduce tuition for all undergraduate courses to \$250 per credit (a \$202/credit savings) for the entire BSN program. To receive this Grant, you must: 1) submit an application for admission and be admitted into the RN to BSN program during the Application Period; 2) submit the Grant application at least one week prior to your expected EXP 105 start date; and 3) begin classes in your RN to BSN program during the Application Period. To maintain eligibility, you must remain continuously enrolled throughout the program or on an approved break. The Grant may not be combined with any other Ashford University grants, scholarships, or discounts. Students who are eligible for the Ashford Military Grant or Leader Development Grant are not eligible for this Grant. Employees of Ashford University (“Ashford”), Ashford’s affiliates, subsidiaries, parent and related companies and agents, and members of the immediate family and/or household of any such employee, are not eligible. All federal, state and local rules and regulations apply. Void where prohibited or restricted by law.

2. HOW TO APPLY: The Grant starts at 9:00 am (Pacific Time) on July 1, 2016 and ends at 5:00 pm (Pacific Time) on June 30, 2017 (the “Application Period”). The Grant is subject to these official rules (“Official Rules”). By entering, all applicants (“Applicants”) agree to be bound by the terms and conditions set forth in these Official Rules. Certain restrictions may apply. To apply, complete the application during the Application Period and submit the completed application to your Enrollment Services Advisor. Your Enrollment Services Advisor’s contact information can be found in their email signature or by calling (866) 711-1700. When you apply for the Grant, you may be asked to consent to receive promotional e-mails and reminders for promotions and information about online education. Consenting to receive such e-mails is optional and is not a requirement for participation in the Grant.

3. GRANT RECIPIENT AWARD NOTIFICATION: Grant recipients will be notified by electronicmail before their expected EXP 105 start date.

4. GRANTS: Each award consists of a Grant toward tuition for the pursuit of an online RN to BSN degree at Ashford. Receipt and use of the Grant is subject to all policies, restrictions and conditions imposed by Ashford as set forth in the Ashford University Catalog, including without limitation Ashford admission requirements and RN to BSN program requirements. The Grant is subject to forfeiture if the recipient falls out of attendance from Ashford University for more than ninety (90) days from the last date of academic activity. The Grant recipients must continuously be enrolled or on an approved break during his/her enrollment to maintain Grant eligibility. Breaks that are less than fourteen (14) days do not require approval. ALL COSTS AND EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH THE RECEIPT OR USE OF THE GRANTS ARE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH RECIPIENT. The Grants are awarded WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, express or

implied, without limitation. The approximate retail value of the Grant may change based on the actual number of attempted courses and credits necessary to successfully complete this program based upon transfer credits accepted by Ashford (e.g. if the actual number of credits necessary to complete this program is 60, the approximate retail value of the Grant is expected to be \$11,580). Any taxes on the Grant value are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Grants consist only of a reduction in the cost per credit for the RN to BSN program and is applied to tuition only. Books, computers, fees, and room and board will continue to be the sole responsibility of the Grant recipient. Any other costs or expenses associated with the acceptance or use of any Grant (including, without limitation, transportation expenses) are the responsibility of the recipient. No substitution or transfer of the Grant or the right to receive the Grant is permitted, except that Ashford may in its discretion substitute for any Grant an alternate Grant of equal or greater value. The Grant takes the form of a non-cash credit to Ashford, and no check or cash payments will be given and/or refunded from any Grant award at any time. No exceptions.

5. GENERAL RULES: This Grant is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. Ashford is not responsible for lost, late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, corrupted, mutilated, misdirected, misdelivered, undelivered, blocked or delayed applications or other communications, or for technical or human errors, delays or failures of any kind in connection with the submission, transmission, processing, storage of entries, including without limitation any malfunctions or failures of computer hardware, computer software, networks or telephone equipment, any data loss or corruption, or any technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any website or any combination thereof. Ashford reserves the right to cancel, suspend and/or modify the Grant, or any part of it, if any fraud, technical failures or any other factor beyond Ashford's reasonable control impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the Grant or if for any reason this program may not be conducted as planned, as determined by Ashford in its sole discretion. In the event of cancellation, suspension or modification of the Grant, a notice will be posted online. Ashford's failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision. Ashford will not be liable to any Applicant or any other person for failure to supply any Grant or any part thereof, by reason of any acts of God, any action(s), regulation(s), order(s), or request(s) by any governmental or quasi-governmental entity (whether or not the action(s), regulation(s), order(s) or request(s) prove(s) to be invalid), equipment failure, terrorist acts, earthquake, war, fire, flood, explosion, unusually severe weather, hurricane, embargo, labor dispute or strike (whether legal or illegal), labor or material shortage, transportation interruption of any kind, work slow-down, civil disturbance, insurrection, riot, or any other cause beyond the control of Ashford. Applicants acknowledge that Ashford has neither made nor is in any manner responsible for any warranty, representation or guarantee, expressed or implied, in fact or in law, related to the Grant. **CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT BY AN APPLICANT TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE ANY WEBSITE OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE GRANT IS A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND/OR CIVIL LAWS AND SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, ASHFORD RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEEK DAMAGES AND OTHER REMEDIES FROM ANY SUCH PERSON TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.** Without limitation of the foregoing, Ashford reserves the right at its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the application process. Ashford is not responsible for any typographical or other error in the printing or communication of the offer, administration of the Grant, or in the announcement of the Grant or the recipients.

As a condition of participating in this program, each Applicant agrees that any and all disputes shall be resolved in accordance with the terms of the enrollment agreement between the Grant recipient and Ashford.
