

## **Banner Health Scholarship Terms and Conditions**

**Effective 5/8/2023** 



The following terms and conditions (the "Terms and Conditions") govern the scholarship opportunity available to select Registered Nurses employed by Banner Health or an approved affiliate (collectively, "Banner") for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing ("BSN") program sponsored by the University of Arizona Global Campus ("UAGC") (the "Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity").

## **OFFICIAL RULES**

NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR BE SELECTED AS A POTENTIAL RECIPIENT. INTERNET CONNECTION REQUIRED. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCE OF BEING SELECTED OR QUALIFYING. THIS SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY IS VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY LAW.

- **1. ELIGIBILITY:** The Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity is available only to select Registered Nurses of Banner who have at least 6 months continuous tenure, are in good standing at the time of Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity application submission, and are able to meet the requirements as outlined below.
  - All applicants must be able to meet UAGC admission requirements as outlined in the UAGC Academic Catalog for applicable degree program level as well as meet all applicable international requirements by June 23, 2023 (11:59 p.m. PT); see below for applicable admission requirements:
    - o Admission Policies and Procedures for Bachelor's Degree Programs
    - Additional Conditional Admission Requirements for Applicants to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (RN to BSN) Program
    - Bachelor's: Additional Admission Requirements for Applicants with International Academic Credentials
    - Inability to meet requirements for admission in their entirety by June 23, 2023, at
      11:59 p.m. (Central Time) will result in disqualification from scholarship eligibility.
  - Applicants must not be an active student at UAGC; current UAGC students are not eligible to complete an application or receive the Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity.
  - Potential recipients must reside in a state where the UAGC BSN program is available.

All federal, state and local rules and regulations apply. Void where prohibited or restricted by law.

**2. HOW TO APPLY:** The Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity application (the "Application") will be available from June 2, 2023, at 12:00 a.m. (PT) through 11:59 p.m. (PT) to June 23, 2023 (the "Application Period"). The scholarship recipients ("Recipients") will be announced by July 24, 2023 (the "Recipient Announcement Date"). By applying, all applicants ("Applicants") agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. The application for the Scholarship Opportunity will be managed by Banner Health. To apply, visit the Banner Health application site <a href="here">here</a>, or you can visit the Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity landing page during the Application Period and follow the application instructions. Applicants will be required to



submit the Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity Application (the "Application"). When you apply for the Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity, you may be asked to consent to receive promotional emails and reminders for promotions and information about online education. Consenting to receive such emails is optional and is not a requirement for participation in the Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity.

- **3. POTENTIAL RECIPIENT SELECTION:** By July 10, 2023, Banner will select potential recipients based on criteria and requirements established by Banner and defined in the Application. The potential recipients will have until July 24, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. (PT) (10 business) to verify they are able to meet UAGC admission requirements. Failure to meet UAGC admission requirements by July 24, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. (PT) will result in disqualification and the potential recipient will not be eligible for scholarship selection. Banner's selection decisions are final and binding in all respects. An alternate recipient ("Alternate Recipient") may be selected in the event an initial recipient declines the scholarship and/or is disqualified.
- **4. POTENTIAL RECIPIENT VERIFICATION AND NOTIFICATION:** Potential recipients are subject to verification by Banner and UAGC, must reside in a state where the BSN program is available, and meet all Eligibility requirements outlined above (See paragraph 1. Eligibility). The potential recipients will be notified by UAGC and Banner by phone and email, by July 10, 2023. If a potential recipient is unreachable by phone after reasonable attempts have been made to contact such potential recipient during a period of seven (7) calendar days, or if a notification is returned as undeliverable, the potential recipient may be disqualified. The potential recipient will be required to complete and return the Banner Health Scholarship Acknowledgement, Waiver, and Release form prior to starting courses. Failure to sign and return all required documents within the specified time period may result in forfeiture and disqualification of the potential recipient and an Alternate Recipient may be selected. Once eligibility for admission is verified, the scholarship has been accepted, and the Banner Health Scholarship Acknowledgement, Waiver, and Release form is approved, the potential recipient is referred to as "Banner Health Scholarship Recipient." Time periods and deadlines specified above may be extended up to thirty (30) additional business days should an Alternate Recipient be selected.
- **5. SCHOLARSHIPS:** A total of up to five (5) full-program scholarships will be awarded for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (RN to BSN) program only. Each award consists of: (a) full program tuition, (b) books and course digital materials (CDM) credit for the entire program, (c) Technology Fee waivers for the entire program, (d) Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) Fee waiver, and (e) Graduation Fee waiver for the pursuit of an online degree from the University of Arizona Global Campus. Receipt and use of the scholarship is subject to all policies, restrictions and conditions imposed by UAGC as set forth in the UAGC Academic Catalog, including without limitation all UAGC admission requirements. ALL FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL TAXES, AND ANY OTHER COSTS AND EXPENSES, ASSOCIATED WITH THE RECEIPT OR USE OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH RECIPIENT. The scholarships are awarded WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, express or implied, without limitation. The approximate retail value of the scholarship will vary depending on the UAGC tuition rate but is estimated to be no more than \$70,950. Any taxes on the scholarship value are the sole responsibility of the Recipients. Scholarships consist only of items expressly specified in these Terms and Conditions. Any costs or expenses associated with the acceptance or use of any scholarship (including, without limitation, transcript fees, living expenses, and graduation regalia) are the responsibility of the Recipients. No substitution or transfer of the scholarship or the right to receive the scholarship is permitted, except that UAGC may in its discretion substitute for any scholarship an alternate scholarship of equal or greater value.



**6. CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP:** The scholarship award will be granted to the Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity Recipients in the form of a non-cash credit to UAGC, and no check or cash payments will be given and/or refunded to any Recipient at any time. Recipients may NOT receive any federal financial aid, including but not limited to Pell Grants and Direct Loans, in any form while participating in the Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity. Recipients must enroll in their program within 90 calendar days following the award date or forfeit the scholarship award. Recipients found to be in violation of the Student Community Standards at any time during their enrollment with UAGC risk revocation of any scholarship awarded, at the sole discretion of UAGC. Receipt and use of the scholarship is subject to all policies, restrictions and conditions imposed by UAGC as set forth in the University of Arizona Global Campus Academic Catalog, including without limitation the University of Arizona Global Campus admission requirements, Satisfactory Academic Progress, and Attendance. Recipients must remain continuously enrolled or on an approved academic leave during their enrollment to maintain scholarship eligibility. Recipients who are out of attendance greater than 180 consecutive days will forfeit the scholarship award. Banner Health Scholarship recipients cannot be receiving any other institutional offers or grants. Recipients must remain actively employed with Banner to participate in the Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity.

**7. PERSONAL INFORMATION:** Information collected via the Application shall be subject to the UAGC privacy policy, which can be viewed at <a href="https://www.uagc.edu/privacy/">https://www.uagc.edu/privacy/</a>. Applicants acknowledge that representatives of UAGC may contact them about enrollment opportunities at the University of Arizona Global Campus and/or may contact Applicants with future communications and offers.

8. MISCELLANEOUS: All Applicants release Banner and the University of Arizona Global Campus ("Program Entities"), and all others associated with the development and execution of this Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity, from any and all claims and liabilities arising from or in connection with participation in the Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity, the delivery, nondelivery, acceptance or use of any scholarship and/or the use of the Applicant's submitted Application as permitted hereunder, including without limitation claims for injury, death, loss or damage of any kind. This Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. The Program Entities are not responsible for lost, late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, corrupted, mutilated, misdirected, misdelivered, undelivered, blocked or delayed applications or other communications, or for technical or human errors, delays or failures of any kind in connection with the submission, transmission, processing, storage or judging of applications, including without limitation any malfunctions or failures of computer hardware, computer software, networks or telephone equipment, any data loss or corruption, or any technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any website or any combination thereof. The Program Entities reserve the right to suspend and/or modify the Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity, or any part of it, if any fraud, technical failures or any other factor beyond the reasonable control of UAGC impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity. This determination will be made by UAGC in consultation with Banner. If the fraud, technical failures, and/or other factors impairing the integrity or proper functioning of the Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity cannot be resolved within a reasonable period of time, UAGC reserves the right to cancel the Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity. In the event of cancellation, suspension or modification of the Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity, a notice will be posted online. Failure by the Program Entities to enforce any term herein shall not constitute a waiver of that provision. The Program Entities will not be liable to any Applicant or any other person for failure to supply any scholarship or any part thereof, by reason



of any acts of God, any action(s), regulation(s), order(s), or request(s) by any governmental or quasi-governmental entity (whether or not the action(s), regulation(s), order(s) or request(s) prove(s) to be invalid), equipment failure, terrorist acts, earthquake, war, fire, flood, explosion, unusually severe weather, hurricane, embargo, labor dispute or strike (whether legal or illegal), labor or material shortage, transportation interruption of any kind, work slow-down, civil disturbance, insurrection, riot, or any other cause beyond the control of the Program Entities. Applicants acknowledge that the Program Entities have neither made nor are in any manner responsible for any warranty, representation or quarantee, expressed or implied, in fact or in law, related to the scholarship award. CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT BY AN APPLICANT TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE ANY WEBSITE OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE BANNER HEALTH SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY IS A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND/OR CIVIL LAWS AND SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA GLOBAL CAMPUS RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEEK DAMAGES AND OTHER REMEDIES FROM ANY SUCH PERSON TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW. Each Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Program Entities from and against any and all claims, liabilities and damages of any kind or nature, including without limitation any copyright infringement claim or claim of violation of the right of privacy.

**9. DISPUTES:** The Banner Health Scholarship Opportunity is governed by the laws of the state of Arizona without giving effect to conflict of law doctrines. As a condition of participating in this opportunity, each Applicant agrees that any and all disputes that cannot be resolved between the parties, and causes of action arising out of or in connection with this opportunity, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, exclusively before a court located in the State of Arizona having jurisdiction, unless otherwise provided in agreements between the Applicant and UAGC. Further, in any such dispute, under no circumstances will any Applicant be permitted to obtain an award of, and hereby waive all rights to claim punitive, incidental or consequential damages, including attorneys' fees, other than Applicant's actual out-of-pocket expenses (e.g. costs associated with applying), and each Applicant further waives all rights to have damages multiplied or increased.
