Introduction

The No Excuses University Teacher Scholarship program will be administered by the Scholarship Committee of the Department of Education & Liberal Arts at the University of Arizona Global Campus in San Diego, CA. The scholarship is available to all teachers affiliated with a No Excuses University (NEU) school. This scholarship covers full tuition and technology fees for a graduate degree within the Department of Education & Liberal Arts at the University of Arizona Global Campus. The scholarship shall be awarded each academic year to a maximum of one teacher from the No Excuses University network of schools.

Submission Instructions

This application is intended for students applying for the NEU Teacher Scholarship to attend the University of Arizona Global Campus. Applicants should apply for the scholarship using this application packet. The NEU Teacher Verification Letter should accompany the application packet. **The completed application and all supplemental documents should be submitted to Neuteacherscholarship@uagc.edu.**

Applications are due to the University of Arizona Global Campus no later than September 15, 2021. You may refer any questions concerning the scholarship program or the application packet to Dr. Allison Rief at allison.rief@uagc.edu or Dr. Tony Farrell at tony.farrell@uagc.edu.

The scholarship shall be awarded each academic year to a maximum of one teacher from the No Excuses University network of schools. The recipient must enroll into a graduate degree program within the Department of Education & Liberal Arts at the University of Arizona Global Campus.

Eligibility Requirements

The scholarship applicant must:

- Have a valid teaching credential;
- Be currently employed as a classroom teacher within the No Excuses University network of schools;
- Complete an essay;
- Complete the NEU Verification Letter;
- Submit a transcript indicating an earned Bachelor's degree; with at least a 2.0 GPA;
- Meet the full admission requirements set forth in the current UAGC Academic Catalog, available at www.uagc.edu/catalog; and
- Enter into an enrollment agreement with UAGC upon acceptance into the degree program.

The scholarship shall be renewable, so long as the recipient maintains satisfactory academic progress as defined by UAGC, remains continuously enrolled or on approved academic leave of absence during his or her program of study, and remains in good standing. The NEU Teacher Scholarship shall not be renewed for students who do not meet these requirements. Also, the scholarship may not be renewed should a recipient be sanctioned as a result of the Student Community Standards Policy as described in the Academic Catalog.

The NEU Teacher Scholarship recipient nomination will be announced on or around October 30, 2021. Final approval of the scholarship recipient lies with the University of Arizona Global Campus. UAGC shall review the nomination against the stated criteria, as stated in the "Agreement" page located in the application packet and issue a final decision in writing to the NEU Teacher Scholarship recipient. Once selection is finalized by UAGC, the NEU Teacher Scholarship recipient shall sign an enrollment agreement and fulfill all other admission requirements at the University of Arizona Global Campus.

The NEU Teacher Scholarship covers full tuition, technology fees and books for one academic year. Current tuition and fees can be found in the [University of Arizona Global Campus Academic Catalog](#).
